

Free market-history games for class

Short investing activities for personal finance, economics, business, DECA, FBLA, Stock Market Game, and enrichment groups.



WHAT IT IS

Charged Alpha turns real historical market events into free investing games. Students make a market decision, then compare their reasoning with the actual historical outcome.

USE CASE

15-minute warmup

Students see a headline, pick a strategy, then discuss what the market actually did.

USE CASE

Full-period lab

Use one game to explore risk, allocation, timing, leverage, and second-order effects.

USE CASE

Club challenge

Run a repeatable activity for investing clubs, DECA, FBLA, or Stock Market Game teams.

QUICK START

- 1 **Open the teacher page** Go to chargedalpha.com/teachers and choose one game.
- 2 **Set the decision** Ask students what they would buy, avoid, or hold before revealing the result.
- 3 **Play the round** Students explain their reasoning while historical data decides the outcome.
- 4 **Debrief** Discuss what changed: risk, timing, diversification, or assumptions.

Advanced students can use the stock library for earnings videos, podcast links, and company comparisons.
